January 30, 1972

January 30, 1972 - In what is to become known as Bloody Sunday, the British Army kills 13 civil rights demonstrators during a peaceful demonstration in the Bogside district of Londonderry. A 14th marcher later dies of his injuries. Thirty-four years later, the official inquiry continues.
